

*Demonstrative Determiners and  
pronouns*

You use **this/these** when people and things are near.  
But when people and things are far away, you use **that/those**.

Singular → this/that

Plural → these/those

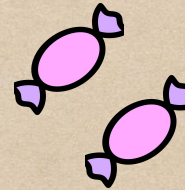
# Examples:

Do you like **these** sweets?



**This** is a nice cafe
