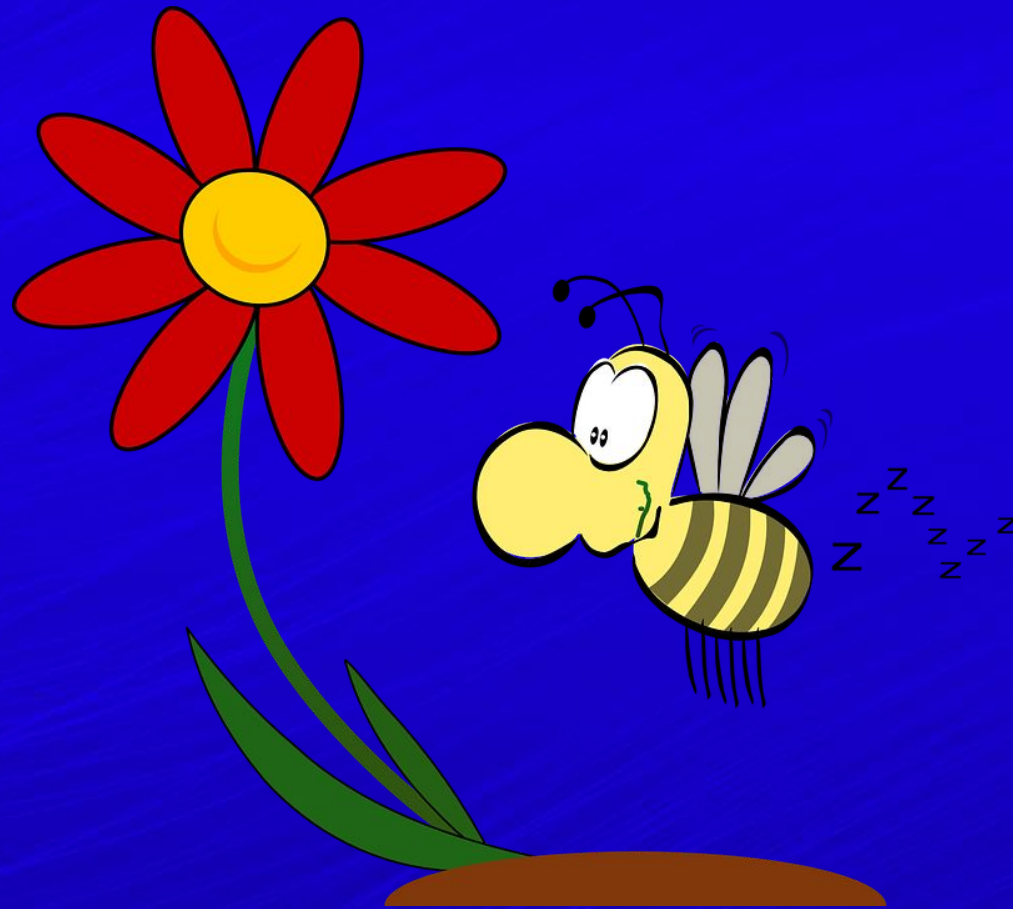


# The s- and of-genitive



## The s-genitive

*You use it when you say that somebody/something is the owner of somebody/something.*

When something belongs to a person, you add an apostrophe with an “s” behind it.

### **Example :**

Ich bin der Bruder von Nadine.

→ I'm Nadine's brother.



When somebody/something belongs to more than one person, you only add an apostrophe without an “s” .

**Example :**

Ich kam in den Laden meiner Eltern.  
→ I came into my parents' shop.

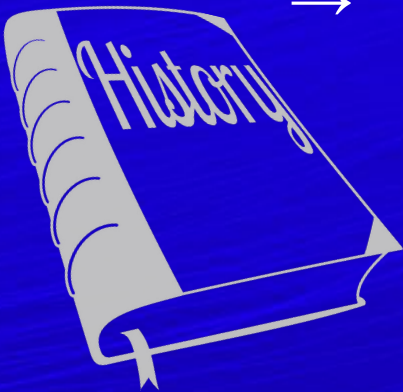


## The of-genitive

When something belongs to something you use “ of ” .

**Example :**

Das Buch beschreibt die Geschichte der Stadt.  
→ This book describes the history of the city.
