RULES:

**IF THE SUBJECT IS THE SAME AS THE OBJECT,
YOU USE A PRONOUN WHICH ENDS WITH -SELF
(SINGULAR) / -SELVES (PLURAL)**

EXAMPLES:

"WE CAN SEE OURSELVES IN THE MIRROR."

OR: "I CAN SEE MYSELF IN THE MIRROR."

OVERVIEW

SINGULAR

I/MYSELF =

ICH-MICH | ICH-MIR

YOU/YOURSELF =

DU-DICH | DU-DIR

HE/HIMSELF = ER-SICH

SHE/HERSELF = SIE-SICH

IT/ITSELF = ES | SIE | ES-SICH

PLURAL:

WE > OURSELVES = WIR-UNS

YOU > YOURSELVES =

IHR-EUCH | SIE-SICH

THEY > THEMSELVES =

SIE-SICH

USE:

YOU USE THE REFLEXIVE PRONOUN WHEN YOU REFER TO A PERSON OR TO A GROUP "ITSELF".

YOU USE EACH OTHER WHEN YOU REFER TO ANOTHER PERSON:

IT TAKES A PICTURE OF ITSELF.

THEY TAKE A PICTURE OF EACH OTHER.
