

Possessive determiners

<u>Subject</u>	<u>Possessive determiners</u>
I	My
You	Your
He	His
She	Her
It	Its
We	Our
You	Your
They	Their

1. The possessive determiner states that something is yours.
2. Most of the time the possessive determiner is standing at the end of the sentence.
3. Every subject has only one possessive determiner.

Examples

As subject:

We have some books.

As pronoun:

The books are **ours**.
